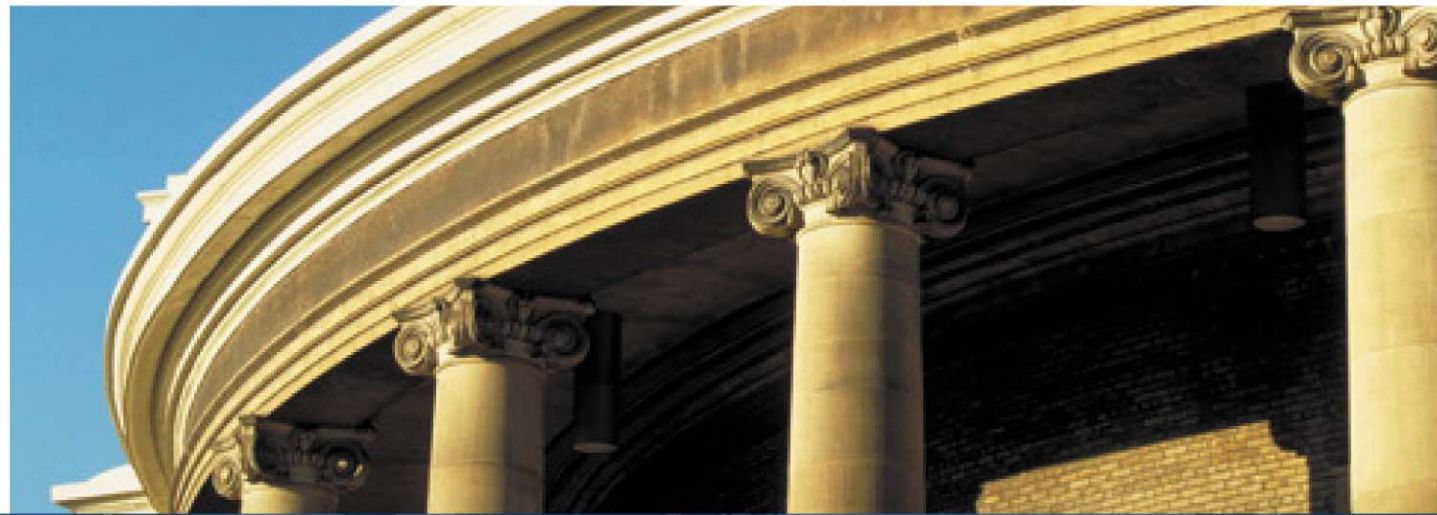

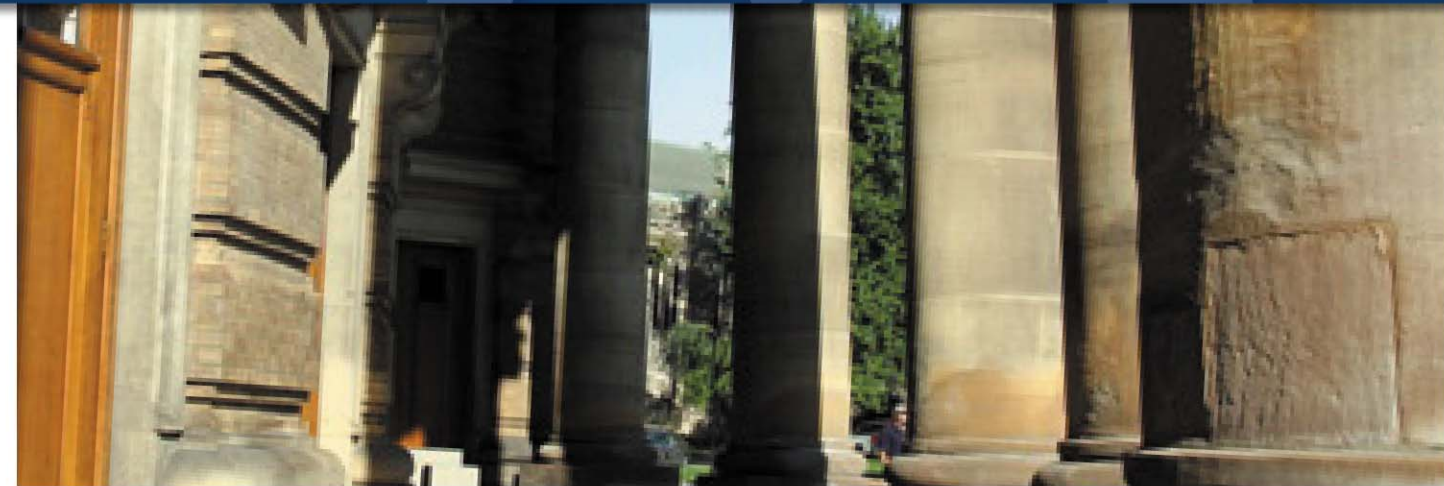

## WHAT IS A UNIVERSITY OF TORONTO HONG KONG SCHOLARSHIP?

The University of Toronto Hong Kong Scholarship program, administered by the University of Toronto (Hong Kong) Foundation, enables students to fulfill their dreams of studying at one of the best research institutions in the world.

Applying is simple, and starts with an on-line form. A single application makes you eligible for all of the scholarships under this program. Candidates to the scholarship program will be guided in the application process to enter the program of their choice at the University of Toronto.

<b>The University of Toronto (Hong Kong) Foundation Scholarship</b> One award of CDN \$22,000 per year (approx. HK\$167,200)	<b>The Dr. Cheng Yung-tung Scholarships</b> Two awards of CDN \$20,000 per year (approx. HK\$152,000)	<b>The Fung Yiu King Memorial Commerce Scholarship</b> One award of CDN \$13,000 for year 1 and CDN\$20,000 for upper years (approx. HK\$98,800 for year 1 and HK\$152,000 for upper years)

All scholarships renewable each year to complete an undergraduate degree in 4 years.

### APPLICATION FAQ

**Am I eligible for the U of T Hong Kong Scholarships?**  
 Application is open to Hong Kong permanent residents who do not hold citizenship in another country outside of Hong Kong and have completed or are in the process of completing their secondary school studies (HKALE, HKDSE or equivalent).

**Who is eligible for financial support?**  
 The scholarships are intended for students whose families can provide some, but not all, funding for an overseas education. Use our online budget tool to determine the costs of studying at the University of Toronto: [www.utoronto.com.hk/scholarships/budget.htm](http://www.utoronto.com.hk/scholarships/budget.htm).

**What makes a successful applicant?**  
 Successful applicants in the past have shown strong academic results, personal initiatives & community leadership, and a genuine interest in living abroad.

**What academic requirements will I need to be eligible?**  
 For students taking the...  
 • HK Advanced Level Examination (HKALE) – five different HKCEE/Ordinary Level subjects, and three Advanced Level subject (excluding the General Paper).  
 • HK Diploma of Secondary Education (HKDSE) - the completed diploma, including at least two elective subjects from categories A and/or C.  
 • International Baccalaureate (IB) - the completed diploma including English HL or SL.
